

Writing:

Using their phonics knowledge and basic sentence structure, children will write their own non-fiction book using a variety of lists, labels and captions,.

Reading:

Our focus texts this half term are:





Maths:

Children will be exploring number through place value, addition and subtraction, with numbers up to 20. They will also explore shape.

Science:

Children will be identifying and naming animals, learning if they are fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds or mammals. They will also learn the difference between herbivores, carnivores and omnivores and match animals to their diet. They will learn about the biologist David Attenborough and discuss what he has done to make a difference.

Hook

Can you create a picture in the style of Henri Matisse's snail?




Can you create a poster about an animal of your choice. Label the features of your animal and write a caption to tell us information about
