

Year 6 Summer term 2



Writing:

Children will enhance their fiction and non-fiction writing skills by composing an environmental speech and a powerful, emotive letter from a Greek soldier.

Maths:

The children will have the opportunity to show off their creative skills by partaking in project work for our upcoming Enterprise Week. Children will create an action plan to raise money for their Year 6 leavers party, decide on their chosen commodity, its price and how to effectively budget for this. Funds raised will go towards their chosen treats.

Science:

Children will focus on consolidating their scientific skills by leading inquiries and investigations throughout the half term. Children will be encouraged to work within groups to think scientifically and work independently to hypothesise and carry out a variety of scientific investigations.

Our topic is: Ancient Greeks



How did the Ancient Greeks influence the Western world?

Hook:

Children will dive straight into our history topic by learning what life was like in Ancient Greece.

Express:

Children will create a poster, model or 3D design to showcase what they have learnt across the term.

<u>History</u>

Children will be exploring their overarching question of how the Ancient Greeks have influenced the Western World. They will explore this by looking at various key aspects of Ancient Greek culture such as philosophers, religion and city states.

PΕ

Children will develop their team building skills and hand-eye coordination skills. They will be able to explain how and why their bodies change during exercise. They will learn a new game called Throlf- a take on golf.

Art:

Children will develop their understanding of Greek architecture, pottery and statues. They will then have the opportunity to design and make their own Greek pottery or statue.

RE:

In Religious Education, children will be looking at the concept of Justice and how this applies to both the Christian and Muslim faiths.

PSHE:

Children will be learning about selfimage, puberty, conception, birth and personal relationships within our 'Changing Me' topic. Parents will have the opportunity to come in to view slides and videos on a selected date if they wish and to ask any questions about the topic.
