## Early Years Summer Term 2

### Communication and Language

Demonstrate understanding of what has been read by retelling stories using their own words and recently introduced vocabulary. Re-enact stories I have heard in my play.

### Physical Development

- Demonstrate strength, coordination and balance when playing.
- Negotiate space and obstacles safely, with consideration for themselves and others.
- Hold a pencil effectively in preparation for fluent writing, using a tripod grip.
- Manage their own personal hygiene.

### Literacy

- Blend sounds to read short simple words & read some words which aren't phonetically decodable.
- Engage with stories at an increasingly deeper level.
- Describe main story settings, events and main characters in increasing detail.
- Write simple phrases and sentences that can be read by others.
